Job Description

Employees specialise in Indigenous land management within the conservation and land management industry sector. Duties may include managing a team, proposing appropriate uses of traditional customs, researching and sharing information on local Australian indigenous cultures.

Summary of Training

- Follow OHS procedures
- Observe environment work practices
- Work effectively in the industry
- Participate in workplace communications
- Respond to emergencies
- Implement revegetation works
- Implement property improvement, construction and repair
- Maintain natural areas
- Prepare and apply chemicals
- Provide appropriate information on cultural knowledge
- Propose appropriate uses of traditional customs
- Work in an Indigenous community or organisation
- Prepare specialised interpretive content (cultural and heritage environments)
- Utilise burning for natural and cultural resource management
- Conduct operational inspection of park facilities
