Certificate II in Water Operations – NWP20107

Job Description

Employees assist with minimising water usage by monitoring the operation of water purification plant, performing basic water sampling, collecting and controlling drainage run-off and operating and maintaining basic flow control and regulating devices.

Summary of Training

- Follow defined OHS procedures and regulatory requirements
- Apply environmental and licensing procedures
- Plan and organise personal work activities
- Perform basic water quality tests
- Use maps, plans, drawings and specification
- Perform and record sampling
- Work effectively in the water industry
- Collect and control
- Use computerised systems
- Operate basic flow control and regulating devices in irrigation systems
- Construct and install water distribution assets
